Ammonia based cleaners

Disinfectants

Use:

Vinegar, salt, water mixture or Baking soda and water

½ lemon dipped in Borax

1 part lemon juice / 2 parts olive oil

boiling water with baking soda, Salt, a piece of aluminum

Baking soda and toilet brush

½ cup Borax in 1 gallon water

¼ cup baking soda plus ¼ cup apple cider vinegar

cornstarch

Cedar chips or lavender flowers

Fine sand paper and light touch

Diluted dish soap or bar soap
